Please number alternative class choices from one to five below in case you are unsuccessful in your Opera Scenes application. **Students choosing Opera Scenes must attend the whole course.**
- The **Song Cycle Class** is also only available to full-week applicants. Successful applicants for the song cycle with Malcolm Martineau may not select additional classes with him as part of their weekly allocation, but may apply for extra classes subject to availability. All Song Cycle Class applications should be received no later than Friday 3rd May. Please number alternative class choices from one to two below in case you are unsuccessful in your Song Cycle Class application.
- **Masterclass** students will work individually with **Karen Cargill** for 30 minutes on any suitable repertoire of their choice. A handful of applicants will also be chosen to take part in the **Public Evening Masterclass on Sunday 28th July**.
